


### **Conclusion**

**GENERAL CIRCULAR:**

**ALL EDUCATION SECTORS:**

**STATE ADAPTATION OF BASIC EDUCATION SECTORIAL WORK PLAN AND MEDIUM-TERM SECTOR STRATEGY AS A STANDARD WORK PLAN AND ALIGNMENT WITH STATE ANNUAL BUDGET.**

Sequel to the above subject matter and the efficiency and accountability in the education sector, this circular is compulsory to all education sectors to adopt the SESS and MTSS as standard work plan for all projects and programs.

**KEY REQUIREMENTS:**

1. Work plan align with state education sectoral strategy to reflect all program/project.
2. Projected funding envelope ceiling for the basic education
3. Align with chart of accounts expenditure classification and program segment
4. Reflect recurrent cost associated with frontline recruitment that covers LGA and state,
5. Submission and Approval. Each education sector must submit their annual work plan to the ministry of education for review and approval.
6. Implementation and monitoring: all education sector must implement their annual work plan and provide quarterly progress report to the state ministry of education.
